- 8. Then with what are these three woes connected?
- 9. To what does the fifth trumpet-the first woerefer?

Ans.-To the rise and spread Mohammedanism. " With surprising unanimity, commentators have agreed in regard to this as referring to the empire of the Saracens, or to the rise and progress of the religion and the empire of Mohammed."- Albert Barnes.

- 10. What did the prophet say should be commanded them ? Rev. 9:4.
- 11. What was commanded them? Gibbon 51: 10. See note.
- 12. For what specific length of time were they to torment men? Verses 5, 10.

答: 1449 年 7 月 27 日。

答: 391 年 15 天。

18. 它什么时候结束?

答: 1840 年 8 月 11 日。

19. 当时有什么历史事件标志着这个时期的结束?

答: 当天,欧洲的四大势力——英国,奥地利,普鲁士和俄罗斯,控制了土耳其政府的所有外交事务,而且从那时起一直持续下去。见"Thoughts on the Revelation",9:18.19。

问题 11——"记住你永远在神面前; 在死亡的边缘, 在审判的保证和天堂的希望 中。避免不公正和压迫; 与你的弟兄商议, 研究如何保持你军队的爱和信任。你们为主 打仗的时候,要像大丈夫一样,不要背道而驰; 但不要让你们的胜利沾上妇女和儿童的血。 不要毁坏棕树, 也不要烧毁麦地, 不要砍伐 果树,也不要伤害牲畜,除非是杀来吃的。 当你立定任何盟约或条款时,要遵守它,并 且要言出必行。当你继续前行时,你会发现 一些宗教人士隐居在修道院中,并主张自己 以这种方式侍奉神; 任凭他们吧, 不要杀他 们,也不要毁坏他们的修道院。你会发现另 一种人,他们属于撒旦的会堂,他们剃光了 头冠; 你一定要劈开他们的头颅, 不给他们 任何机会, 直到他们转变为穆罕默德教徒或 对其教致敬意。"

13. When did this period begin?

Ans. -It was on the twenty-seventh day of July, in the year twelve hundred and ninety-nine of the Christian Era, that Othman first invaded the territory of Nicomedia.-Gibbon, chap. 64, par. 13.

- 14. Then at what time did the first woe end? Ans.-July 27, 1449.
- 15. What followed? Rev. 9:13.
- 16. How long was the sixth trumpet-the second woe-to continue? Verse 15.
- 17. Literally what length of time is this? Ans.-391 years and 15 days.
- 18. When did it end? Ans.-August 11, 1840.
- 19. What historical event marks the ending of this time at that date?

Ans.-On that day the four great powers of Europe,-England, Austria, Prussia, and Russia,--assumed control of all the foreign affairs of the Government of Turkey, and have held it ever since. See "Thoughts on the Revelation," 9:18, 19.

## NOTE.

QUESTION 11.- "Remember that you are always in the presence of God; on the verge of death, in the assurance of judgment, and the hope of Paradise. Avoid injustice and oppression; consult with your brethren, study to preserve the love and confidence of your troops. When you fight the battles of the Lord, acquit yourselves like men, without turning your backs; but let not your victory be stained with the blood of women or children. Destroy no palm trees, nor burn any fields of corn. Cut down no fruit trees, nor do any mischief to cattle, only such as you kill to eat. When you make any covenant or article, stand to it, and be as good as your word. As you go on, you will find some religious persons who live retired in monasteries, and propose to themselves to serve God that way; let them alone, and neither kill them nor destroy their monasteries. And you will find another sort of people that belong to the synagogue of Satan, who have shaven crowns; be sure you cleave their skulls, and give them no quarter till they either turn Mahometans or pay tribute."
